

- 5. The teaching Departments raised the issue of full time faculty requirements. This was conveyed to the Management for consideration and necessary steps.
- 6. The eligible research supervisors were encouraged and instructed to get the recognition for research centers of the college.
- 7. The IQAC was instructed to take necessary steps for the collection and compilation of the data required for AQAR 2017-18.
- 8. The various issues from teaching were addressed. The Principal resolved the certain issues.


